Teen Classroom and Behind the Wheel Instruction

Our Program includes 30 hours of Classroom & 12 hours of Behind the Wheel (BTW) which consists of 6 hrs. of driving and 6 hrs. of BTW observation). BTW starts after the classroom portion is completed.

- ✓ **Students must be at least 15 years old**, or turn 15 before the end of the classroom session in which the student is enrolled.
- ✓ **30 hours of classroom instruction** - 15 classes @ 2 hours each. The Secretary of State regulations do not allow more than 4 absences during classroom hours and requires that all classes missed must be made up. *All make-up classes are scheduled through the classroom instructor.*

- **Free pick up and drop off for each Behind the Wheel Session at either the student's home or High School (pick up and drop off location must be within our service area)**

BTW Information:

*Students who live outside our service area can opt to take the Gold or Silver Program. This will allow BTW scheduling to include a Saturday and/or Sunday. However, the Pick-up and Drop-off will be at a Tri-County Driving School location. Saturday and Sunday Behind the wheel sessions are typically scheduled early to late mornings.

Student must provide proof that they have passed at least eight courses during the previous two school semesters in order to obtain their Letter of Completion. School Administrator must sign this form. Home-school students require a form signed by their parent. The students' instructor will provide further instruction of this form during the classroom portion of the program. (Rev.2.1.19)
