Our Program includes 30 hours of Classroom & 12 hours of Behind the Wheel (6 hrs. of driving and 6 hrs. of observation) after the classroom portion is completed.

- ✓ **Students must be at least 15 years old**, or turn 15 before the end of the classroom session in which the student is enrolled.
- ✓ **30 hours of classroom instruction** - 15 classes @ 2 hours each. The Secretary of State regulations do not allow more than 4 absences during classroom hours and requires that all classes missed must be made up. *All make-up classes are scheduled through the classroom instructor.*

Get Your PERMIT after 4 hours of classroom; student must be at least

15 years old. A Permit Application will be given to a student that allows them to take the written knowledge test at the Secretary of State's office. The following items are to be taken with the student when they take the written test:

- **Original** Birth Certificate issued by the State or County (no copies allowed)
 - **Original** Social Security card (no copies allowed)
 - **1 additional piece of identification** to verify the student's address. See the Rules of the Road book for acceptable forms of identification.
 - **\$20.00 fee** (cash or checks made payable to Secretary of State)
 - **Parent or legal guardian** must accompany student
 - **Passport** will satisfy Birth Certificate requirement.
- ✓ **Payment Plans** – We offer different payment plans based on promotional offers.
 - ✓ **Textbooks:** Student will have option to **LEASE** or **PURCHASE** a textbook for classroom. Textbook fee is paid on the **FIRST** day of class.
 - ✓ **Sibling Discount:** We offer extra savings for siblings. Only 1 discount per student allowed. This offer cannot be combined with any other offer.
 - ✓ **Flexible hours** for your convenience (Instructors available 7 days a week).
 - ✓ **Free pick-ups and drop-offs** (BTW instruction must be within our service area).

\$50.00 fees may apply for failure to do the following:

- Show up for a scheduled BTW appointment.
- Give at least a minimum 24-hours notice when canceling a scheduled BTW appt.
- Have their valid permit present at the time of a BTW session.
- Pay the outstanding tuition balance by the due date.

Student must provide proof that they have passed at least eight courses during the previous two school semesters in order to obtain their Letter of Completion. School Administrator must sign this form. Home-school students require a form signed by their parent. The students' instructor will provide further instruction of this form during class.
